### Footnotes

WAR SHAMAN showed eagerness from outset to share early command from the two path, trekked between rivals through the opening half and shook clear in the homestretch for the score. MATAGOT settled into second flight and between rivals for the opening stages then dueled down the stretch for place with. RELATIVELY CORRECT, winning that duel to secure the place. RELATIVELY CORRECT trekked as the widest of rivals in the second flight, swung to four wide through the far turn and was outdueled in the stretch for the place and had to settle for show. ONE MINT JULEP shared command from outset as the inner rival of the early duo but failed to sustain bid in late stages. NEARLY WAS MINE lacked a closing kick to end a three wide trip. JUSTICA saved ground and passed tiring foe in latter portion of contest. MARION'S JEWELL rushed from outset to gain an advantage early, drifted out through the first turn while clear of all rivals then steadily faded thereafter.
