**Footnotes**

BASIN ST. HEIRESS was within striking distance early five wide, vied into the turn, dueled three wide at the quarter pole, inched away nearing the eighth pole and drew clear in deep stretch. ZEBBA was unhurried early between rivals, rallied in the stretch four wide, finished willingly but was unable to catch the winner. RED'S LASS was allowed to settle early five wide, placed a steady effort and gained the show in deep stretch. SAVANNAH SUZY prompted the early pace four wide, loomed up to gain the advantage, dueled into the stretch then flattened in the drive. REACH FOR IT forced the early pace from between foes then tired and gave way. ESPIRITA was off slow early, went six wide and placed a mild effort. PUNKY ANN was outrun early racing five wide, drifted out mid track late and passed tiring foes. WILDLEIGH GOLDEN dueled from between foes, was used up early and faded. GALLOPING GERTIE dueled from between foes into the turn then gave way. VENUS AVENUE showed little in a dull effort. DEVIL JONES rushed up along the rail to show some brief speed then stopped.
