**Footnotes**

DOMS TRICK set the early pace from the outside, drew clear in the stretch and was kept to task. AGAPITO'S SEA WAR was unhurried early, gained steadily five wide in the stretch and was up for the place. FLASHY RED ODD'S was forwardly placed early, went four wide to place a brief bid then weakened. LITTLE BIT SHADY was outrun early, went four wide and placed a mild effort late. ONESTEPATATIME forced the early pace three wide, sustained a brief bid then gave way. NIGHT VICTOR was off slow early and lacked a closing effort late. SILVER DEVIL R F raced mid pack then faded. YOAKUMCOUNTYKID showed little in a dull effort. EXCESSIVE LANE broke slow, raced wide and failed to threaten. CARSON PRINCE raced off the inside and faded steadily. FINAL CHOICE pressed the early pace from the rail then retreated.
