GHOST SMASHER was rated in hand just off the inside, took over two wide on the second turn then steadily widened with mild urging in the lane. PACHE ECHO STAR broke outward, brushing GLENWOOD AUGGIE, gradually progressed three or four wide, took over second in the stretch, gave futile chase but was easily second best. GLENWOOD AUGGIE crowded at the break, slowly advanced just off the inside, swung out five wide entering the lane and caught BAD BOY BULL for third nearing the wire. BAD BOY BULL quickly moved clear and took the inside, was challenged on the second bend and did not have enough left the last quarter mile. SINGER'S PROSPECT was well placed inside but flattened out the last two furlongs. REZ COMMAND raced in contention just outside SINGER'S PROSPECT to the second turn then began to give way. STRATER ran in midpack from path three for more than a half mile, moved to the inside on the second bend and faded. THE TURKINATOR faded from between rivals on the backstretch, saved ground on the second turn, angled out some for the drive and had little to offer. SADLERS POWERTRAIN void of speed from inside, swung out to path five for the stretch run and had no late bid. JUSTA SLUMDOG broke inward, was steadied, improved position some from outside on the backstretch, gave way on the second turn and was allowed to coast the last eighth.
