Footnotes

LUNCH BOX shared the lead from inside, did not keep up while along the rail on the second turn, took over under a steady drive in the lane and held off SAGAPONACK under a steady drive. SAGAPONACK was hustled along between horses from the beginning, gradually advanced five wide, angled in some entering the lane, gained second midstretch, did not have enough to get by LUNCH BOX late but pulled away for the place. DORITA'S DREAM settled along or just off the rail the first half mile, picked up his pace and angled out into the second turn, progressed three wide, could not close the gap on the top pair the last eighth but caught BROTHER WARBUCKS for third late. BROTHER WARBUCKS bumped with DIGITIZER at the break, advanced two wide to vie for the lead on the backstretch, moved ahead on the second bend but slowly wore down for the drive. DIGITIZER bumped with BROTHER WARBUCKS at the start, progressed widest of all on the second turn but leveled off for the stretch run. DOUBLEUPTOCATCHUP backed up from between rivals going to the halfway point, was blocked just off the rail on the second bend, swung out to path six at the head of the lane and failed to have a significant bid. SHOWTIME DON was prominent between horses through the early going, three to five wide taking the second turn and flattened for the drive. REEL AFFAIR bumped after the start, soon had the lead, drifted out badly on the first turn, challenged from both sides going to the second bend and gave way four wide shortly after. RAISED WESTERN drifted out after the start to bump REEL AFFAIR, ran in contention between horses for more than a half mile but faded along the rail on the second bend.
