DEVIL'S PROSPECTOR forced the early pace from the two path, placed a bid to gain command nearing the quarter pole and widened late. DE DUM was within striking distance early, rallied four wide into the stretch and gained the place. SPECIAL RIGAL set the early pace drawing clear briefly, was challenged nearing the three eighths marker, then weakened but held the show. DANCER'S LEDGEND was unhurried early, was wide into the stretch and placed a mild bid. DONA ANA was off slow early and improved her position in the stretch. ELISABETH JANE was outrun early and lacked a late response. GOLDEN JOSHI raced mid pack and lacked an effort late. LA GROUSH was forwardly placed then gave way. BUE BUE'S STORM trailed the field and was always outrun.
