ASSAULT N BATTERY was kept close just off the inside, angled out to start his bid leaving the turn, fanned to path seven for room, angled in some upper stretch as he rallied, took over midstretch then was driven clear. P. T. CAT disputed the pace between horses, was two wide on the turn, drifted out to path four into the lane, was bumped nearing the furlong marker then brushed several times with ME A PACHE as they battled for second the last eighth. ME A PACHE bumped and forced wider on the backstretch, angled in some going to the bend, vied for the lead three wide with a quarter mile left, was carried out to path five into the lane, lugged in upper stretch, bumped P. T. CAT, brushed several times with the latter as he fought for second but did not have enough in the waning yards. STORM ONTHE BORDER getting out early, bumped ME A PACHE, was checked when his path narrowed at the half mile marker, advanced four wide on the turn, lost considerable ground fanning widest for the drive, closed the gap some upper stretch and was getting to the second pair late. DIESEL INJUN displayed early speed inside, could not keep up leaving the turn, swung out to path six into the lane and gradually faded. BRH RUN raced in contention between rivals on the backstretch but gave way along the rail on the turn.
