Footnotes

PATTY'S PULPIT shared the lead outside from the beginning, was forced to stay in path four through the bend, gained a narrow advantage upper stretch, was headed but dug in through the waning yards and edged ahead in time. WALTZING ROSE settled outside on the backstretch, angled in to be just off the rail into the turn, commenced her bid, floated out a bit to be beside PATTY'S PULPIT upper stretch as she vied for the lead, had a small lead with a furlong to go, fought gamely but had to settle for second best. MIRROR BALL (GB) bumped at the break, disputed the pace between rivals, stayed in path three taking the turn, gradually yielded once in the lane but was easily best of the rest. MISSING MY POINT an early factor from inside, came off the rail some for a clear path entering the stretch and lacked a significant bid. PROFOUND SILENCE weaved slightly inward then back out leaving the chute, came off the inside early on, gradually angled out further through the turn and failed to respond for the drive. PEGGY SUE WHO broke outward, bumping MIRROR BALL (GB), quickly recovered, contested the pace from inside but began to tire leaving the turn, steadily gave way and was bearing out near the wire.
