Footnotes

I'LL RUN FOR MAMA advanced from outside, was in path four through the second turn, took over midstretch and gradually opened up under a drive. LADY EM moved up between horses to share the lead outside GO GO GHOST, drew clear from path three on the second bend, could not stay with I'LL RUN FOR MAMA the last furlong but was easily second best. PETITE PLAYER forwardly placed between rivals, followed LADY EM'S path on the second turn, swung out widest for the stretch run, threaten midstretch, was no match for the top pair in the late going but unchallenged for third. TRICK FALLS chased from just off the inside, was two or three wide improving position through the second turn and upper stretch but leveled off the last eighth. SUPER STORMY without early speed, moved to the rail on the second turn and gradually advanced without threatening. GO GO GHOST displayed early speed between horses, began to yield just off the inside on the second turn, floated out some for the drive and continued to fade. WAKE UP DOLL trailed from inside, altered out for a clear path into the second turn, drifted out further midway on that bend, moved back inside leaving the turn and was empty for the drive. FINISHRICH ON TIME showed a bit of early speed, gained the rail on the first turn, began to tire before finishing a half mile, steadily gave way from inside, floated out into the lane, was eased through the stretch and walked off. BASIN ST. HEIRESS chased from outside, start her bid four wide on the second bend, began to bear out leaving that turn, was pulled up soon after and vanned off.
