Footnotes

JOSE PRADO broke inward, was kept close from inside, progressed through the turn, came off the rail some entering the stretch, altered in a bit when CRUSHER LANE crossed his path inside the last eighth and got up near the wire. CRUSHER LANE broke inward, contested the pace between horses, was headed from outside while just off the rail through the bend, was crowded at the top of the lane, altered in, moved clear soon after, drifted out under left-handed pressure after entering the final furlong, was corrected but narrowly outfinished. SILVER MATTHAIS soon moved to the outside, was in path four then five through the turn, his rider lost his whip just after entering the stretch, battled gamely but lacked the extra needed in the waning yards. EIGHTNCHANGEEGROOM vied for the lead outside CRUSHER LANE, floated out to path four into the lane, lugged in soon after to crowd CRUSHER LANE, was quickly brought back out, dueled between rivals, was checked when CRUSHER LANE came out after entering the last eighth and did not recover in time. MURDEROUS forwardly placed between rivals, lost ground four wide on the bend, swung out to the middle of the track for the stretch run and could only make up minor ground late. UPTOWN EGO steadied some to stay clear of JOSE PRADO just after the start, advanced just off the rail on the turn, angled out to path four upper stretch and lacked a significant response. CHIEF LAZ crowded at the break, soon trailed from outside, stayed off the inside through the turn and made up slight ground deep stretch. NEW MEXICO KID void of speed between horses, was widest taking the turn, came into the stretch behind MURDEROUS, angled in some for a better path but had little to offer. The rider of EIGHTNCHANGEEGROOM lodged an objection alleging interference from CRUSHER LANE inside the last furlong. After their review, the stewards did not uphold that claim.
