RIVER GRADE TRICK broke sharply then settled into stride four wide, rallied nearing the quarter pole, drew clear and was full of run late. TING set a pressured early pace from along the inside, was challenged into the stretch, yielded in the drive drifting out near the sixteenth pole and was no match late. STAR DREAMER was unhurried early, went five wide and placed a mild effort late. MISSALL forced the early pace from between rivals then weakened after a quarter. LEADSHANK was outrun racing wide throughout and was not a factor. CHASING OUR DREAMS saved ground along the inside, was taken up in the turn, drifted out in the stretch while being eased to the wire and was vanned off after pulling up.
