Footnotes

AZTHEHOTWALKTURNS bumped at the start, shared the lead in hand between horses, moved clear and angled in leaving the turn, widened under a drive in the stretch and held off SANTIAGO'S LOVE under urging. SANTIAGO'S LOVE forwardly placed outside, was three wide taking the turn then found best stride too late the last furlong. INDIAN FLAG in contention between horses, was just off the rail on the turn, lost ground fanning five wide for the stretch run then made a strong but belated bid the final eighth. GREAT ARTURO bumped at the break, was settled just off the inside, began to pick up his pace three wide on the bend and also rallied belatedly in the stretch. LITTLE BIT SHADY broke outward, bumping solidly with HOLLYWOOD HARRY, contested the pace from inside, could not stay with AZTHEHOTWALKTURNS, leaving the turn, came off the rail some and lacked the extra needed for the drive. RADIO ROCK STAR gradually angled out going to the turn, moved back to be just off the rail on the bend then lodged a mild bid through the stretch without threatening. HOLLYWOOD HARRY pinched solidly between horses at the start, failed to menace in a wide trip. TRICK CALL broke inward, bumping GREAT ARTURO, advanced inside, swung out four wide on the turn and lacked a significant stretch response.
