HERBAL SLEW set the early pace drawing clear racing off the rail, held a safe advantage into the stretch, was challenged nearing the wire and just lasted. ADMIRAL'S CROWN was bumped at the break, then stalked the early leader three wide, placed a bid into the stretch between rivals, finished well with a late surge nearing the wire and just missed. FOURTEEN KT. GOLD was within striking distance early, went five wide down the backstretch, vied into the stretch four wide, closed well but was unable to get by the top two. HIGH ROCKER was bumped at the break, then moved up to prompt the pace from along the inside and flattened in the stretch. D E PARTYNEVERENDS was off slow early, raced wide throughout and improved his position in the stretch. SOME FUN drifted out some into the first turn, then settled into stride racing four wide and lacked a gain late. TIDE IN TIDE OUT hopped at the start breaking outward, angled in to save ground and failed to threaten. RAINING PUNCHES dropped back steadily racing off the rail and was not a factor.
