KILIAN'S BLEND pressed the pace, gained command while racing three wide into the stretch, responded to steady right handed urging and drew clear late. OL WINEDRINKER WHO was never far back while racing between foes, was in tight in mid stretch, forcing his rider to steady a bit and finished willingly when clear. SWISSWRISTWATCH was away alertly to stalk the leaders while racing three wide and showed a good effort. WHISKEY TRIP raced in mid pack along the inside and improved his position late. SWAPIANO was allowed to settle into stride, raced five wide into the lane and passed tired ones. FOOLIN WHO set the pace while saving ground, opened up a clear lead and weakened after four and a half furlongs. GOOD THING GOING raced in contention early, slipped through to offer a bid at the quarter pole and tired in the drive. FUGIACOMO trailed the field for a half mile, raced four wide into the stretch and never threatened. AIN'TNOSLOWRIDE broke sharply, was allowed to settle into stride, fanned four wide out of the turn and failed to menace. IRON AXE hopped at the start, angled to the far outside shortly after that and showed no rally.
