SHES A BLUE prompted the early pace from the outside, placed a bid to gain a short lead, was challenged in deep stretch, dueled to the wire, took a bad step at the wire and was vanned off after pulling up. MISS A T M MACHINE set a pressured early pace, lost the advantage into the turn, battled back in deep stretch, dueled to the wire in a game try but outfinished. VENUS AVENUE was unhurried early, advanced steadily into the stretch and was along for the show. QUEEN RING A DING was outrun early while saving ground and placed a mild effort late. CHEROKEE FLAG was bumped at the break, raced mid pack and lacked a closing response. TOM ES LA BULLY raced wide throughout and failed to menace. SPECIAL BEANS chased the early leaders three wide and was finished early. SPECIAL EGO was unhurried early, dropped back and was not a factor.
