FOURTEEN KT. GOLD was unhurried early, vied three wide splitting foes in the turn, angled four wide in the stretch and steadily edged clear. MR. SCARFACE prompted the early pace saving ground, shuffled back into the stretch, angled three wide and closed to gain the place. UPTOWN EGO was allowed to settle early four wide, made a move mid way and battled for the show in the late going. BIRDIE'S GENIUS was off slow early, gained steadily four wide, drifted out late and placed a mild effort. THISSANCHOISOKAY forced the early pace five wide then weakened in the drive. MIDNIGHT MAVRICK set the early pace racing off the rail, held to the eighth pole then was challenged and gave way. HEZA RARE BULL raced wide and was not a factor. HI HENNESSY was off slow to trail the field, went five wide and was not a threat.
