Footnotes

TEXAS SILVER prominent from inside, went for the lead along the rail leaving the bend, came to even terms on the front end upper stretch, tried to drift out, though under a steady right whip and bumped with BOLIVAR SHAG nearing the eighth pole, continued to try to get out and jostled solidly with the latter as he edged ahead nearing the wire. CELZO'S BIRDIE pressed from between horses, made his bid three wide into the turn and came to share the lead soon after, was bumped upper stretch, fought gamely, jostled nearing the wire and outfinished. BOLIVAR SHAG soon had the lead between rivals, was challenged from outside into the bend, caught in tight quarters upper stretch, bumped and forced into CELZO'S BIRDIE, battled gamely in close quarters after that but was squeezed solidly between TEXAS SILVER and CELZO'S BIRDIE in the waning yards. DANSEUR WITH STARS displayed early speed from outside, took the turn four wide, began to weaken in the lane, drifted out some midstretch, was corrected but did not have enough left. BORN BOND angled out through the turn, came widest into the lane, angled out some as DANSEUR WITH STARS came out midstretch and was getting to the latter inside the final sixteenth. HEZA ALLIGATOR an early factor from inside, could not keep up through the bend, angled out some upper stretch and lacked a significant response. There was a stewards' inquiry into the bumping that went on among TEXAS SILVER, BOLIVAR SHAG and CELZO'S BIRDIE through the stretch. There was also an objection lodged by the rider of BOLIVAR SHAG alleging interference from CELZO'S BIRDIE in the lane. After their review, TEXAS SILVER was disqualified for initiating the repeated interference to BOLIVAR SHAG and CELZO'S BIRDIE and placed third.
