### Footnotes

E R F SILVER BUNNY was unhurried early along the inside, angled out five wide into the stretch, closed well when asked and surged clear. RETREAT HOME was within striking distance early, rallied five wide near the three sixteenths, gained a short lead at the eighth pole but failed to hold off closing foe. BREA was allowed to settle early racing five wide, began to close the gap in the turn, angled between foes in the stretch three wide, sustained a bid then yielded in the late going. HALOS PARROT BAY was outrun early saving ground, vied in the stretch, altered out near the sixteenth pole splitting foes and showed some interest late. PRIDE OF GOLD was never far back early saving ground, angled out near the five sixteenths, went six wide in the stretch and placed a mild bid. EASILY A TWELVE was off slow early, circled the field into the stretch, went seven wide and sustained a mild effort. EMMASVALENTINEGIRL set the early pace six wide, drew clear angling in to save some ground, was used up early and gave way. GOLDIEWHIZ was forwardly placed early four wide then faded steadily. SPECKLED LADY pressed the early pace six wide and was finished early. PRINCESS MCKENZY dropped back to trail the field racing wide and was not a factor.
