PLAID rated from inside, went for the lead two wide on the second bend, gained the advantage at the eighth pole, drifted out some under a left whip with a sixteenth left, was corrected and edged ahead under a drive. SHOW ME YOUR GLORY broke alertly, set the pace inside, was challenged in the lane, slowly wore down but easily best of the rest. VISUAL EFFECT settled, saved ground, lodged a mild bid along the rail leaving the second bend and passed tired ones to take over third late. TALE OF FREEDOM broke outward, was steadied back from tight quarters going to the first turn, moved up between rivals on the backstretch, came three wide into the lane and lacked a late bid. DANCING SQUALL crowded at the break, was in midpack early, progressed just off the inside on the second bend then flattened out for the drive. DANCE WITH DANA pressed SHOW ME YOUR GLORY from between rivals but gave way three wide on the second turn. WHERE WOODY BEA prompted the pace briefly but faded between rivals on the backstretch. PRINCESS PATRICIA hesitated then made a leap from the gate, failed to menace from outside and lost contact with the field through the lane.
