Footnotes

DIESEL INJUN showed first as he broke inward some, moved ahead just off the inside on the backstretch, was challenged again entering the second bend, stayed just off the rail, shook free upper stretch and held sway under steady urging. REZ COMMAND pressed DIESEL INJUN from just outside, went for the lead on the second turn, could not stay abreast upper stretch, never relented, did not have enough late but was clearly second best. SPECIAL AGENT SLEW broke outward, was prominent between horses, advanced two wide on the second bend, lacked the needed stretch bid, fought for third and narrowly held off his rivals. TRIPLE STAR a step slow at the break, was then steadied behind SPECIAL AGENT SLEW, trailed from outside, gradually picked up his pace, came four wide into the stretch, gradually angled in looking for a clear path as he battled for the show but did not have enough in the waning yards. CHIEF LAZ boxed in behind the early speed while just off the inside, weaved inside then back to the outside to make his way through traffic into the second turn, was five wide at the head of the lane, had every chance but gradually yielded instead. STORMIN GHOST bore out at the break, was settled, just off the inside taking the second turn, altered in for room upper stretch, closed the gap some and was forced to alter to path three in the late going. R BUD forced out at the start, advanced outside to be forwardly placed leaving the first bend, failed to keep up five wide through the second turn and lugged in as he continued to give way through the lane. KHAM ARTIST crowded briefly at the start, vied for the lead from inside, gradually backed up along the rail on the backstretch and had little left after five furlongs.
