FOR FILLIES AND MARES THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$300 to pass the entry box. Starters to pay \$300 additional with \$55,000 guaranteed to be divided 60% to the winning owner, 22% to second, 10% to third, 4% to fourth and 2% to fifth and sixth. Weights; Three year olds; 121lbs. Older 123lbs. Non-winners of a sweepstakes since May 4, 2011 allowed 2lbs. \$23,000 in 2011 allowed 4lbs. (maiden and claiming races not considered in allowances). Starters to be named through the entry box at the usual time of closing. High weights preferred according to the scale of weights. Total earnings in 2010-2011 will be used to determine preference to horses assigned equal weights. This race will be limited to twelve starters. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner.

HAYLEY'S HALO set a well handled pace from the start, drew off on the turn then was in a long drive and held sway in the end. QUEEN GREELEY chased the pace while racing two wide, rallied on the turn making a bid but was second best in the end. PYRITE ON MY MIND was allowed to settle while inside, rallied on the turn then moved out to be three wide for the stretch drive but was no menace in late stretch. LAST WAGER was allowed to settle then raced three wide on the turn, made a bid and moved out to be five wide for the stretch drive but came up empty in late stretch. CHALULA ONE broke slowly from the gate then was settled, made a bid four wide in upper stretch then flattened out in the drive. ANGEL AT HOME was unhurried early then raced two wide on the turn but was no threat. LOOSE PLAY pressed the pace while two wide, was used up then gave way in the stretch. D' ELEGANCE dwelt at the start and was far back. A stewards inquiry was held concerning the start. After reviewing the films, no action was taken.
