CARSON'S ATTACK drew quickly clear, held a safe advantage throughout and opened up in the stretch. SUPER SALTY tracked the early leader saving ground, vied but was no match late and clearly the best of the rest. HALO'S IRON LOOP was well back early racing six wide, rallied into the stretch, showed some effort late, was no threat to the top two but gained the show. MARTY SQUALL chased the early leader three wide, lacked a gain and yielded in the drive. SECRET ROCKET was forwardly placed early between rivals then weakened. BAY VELVET was off slow early, saved ground and improved his position in the stretch. TOBAPRINCE raced mid pack three wide and lacked a late response. OCATE was close early racing four wide then faded in the lane. WICKED WHISKEY was outrun early, dropped back in the turn, went eight wide in the stretch and lacked a rally. SHADY DEAL raced well back and was not a threat. ELIJAH'S SON showed little in a dull effort.
