Footnotes

LOOK'N SPIFY rated just off the inside on the backstretch, weaved around traffic on the turn, came four wide into the lane, gained a slight advantage, battled to hold the lead, drifted out a bit deep stretch, bumped with HI HENNESSY but held sway. HI HENNESSY broke inward, bumping LOOK IN SEATTLE, was then forced out, advanced from outside, lost ground five wide on the turn, drifted out some further entering the stretch, vied for the lead, lugged in some through the waning yards, bumped with LOOK'N SPIFY, could not get by the latter but proved easily best of the rest. DIXIE FILM was in midpack early between horses, gained the inside on the turn, took over third and threatened along the rail in the lane, hung the in the late going but pulled away for the show. DUN AVENUE contested the pace between horses, three wide into the stretch and lugged in some going to the eighth pole as he began to wear down. BORN BOND void of speed off the inside, advanced two wide on the turn, swung out to path four entering the lane, progressed to midstretch then leveled off. RIVER JONES broke greenly then had to alter out to stay clear of HI HENNESSY, improved position five wide on the bend, angled in some

leaving the turn then had to alter out several times to advance in the lane. HELIOBULL showed no speed between rivals, was five wide into the turn, drifted out to the middle of the track leaving the bend and failed to have a stretch bid. HEZA TRICK unruly behind the gate, broke sharply, dueled for the lead from inside, floated out a bit leaving the turn, began to fade, drifted out some upper stretch and continued to give way. GROUND POUNDER was soon well back between horses, three wide taking the turn, angled in midstretch and failed to have a late bid. LOOK IN SEATTLE was also unruly behind the gate before the start, bumped by HI HENNESSY at the break, soon trailed, was just off the inside on the turn, angled three wide for a clear path upper stretch and had little to offer. SCAT'DAT forced in shortly after the start, was then checked behind traffic, showed no speed in a ground-saving trip, was steadied when crowded by MS HOLLYWOOD SYNC upper stretch, soon clear of that one but had no rally. MS HOLLYWOOD SYNC dueled for the early lead from outside, began to shorten stride on the turn, was then checked as she faded in traffic, weaved as she steadily gave way upper stretch, eased the last eighth and walked off.
