CAPE TIME broke alertly, set a pressured pace in hand, was roused on the second turn, lost the lead, never relented, dug in under a drive with a furlong left, began to drift out in the waning yards but held sway. SHOOTER'S TOUCH rated just off the inside, commenced his bid three wide on the second bend, fanned out some entering the lane, drifted out to path six upper stretch, held a straight course the last furlong, gradually closed the gap and proved clearly second best. PAY THE VIG pressed CAPE TIME from just outside, took the lead on the second turn but began to wear down the last eighth. SEA BATTLE broke outward, was an early contender between horses, failed to keep up four wide on the second turn, fanned out further for the stretch run and had no late bid. A LOT OF MON void of speed, gradually improved position along the inside, floated out some entering the lane, closed the gap some upper stretch then leveled off. TOSS crowded briefly at the break, showed no speed from outside, angled in entering the second turn to be just off the inside, swung out to path four into the lane and had no late bid. TACO BILLY raced in contention four or five wide to the second turn then gave way. HOPE FOR PEACE steadily faded from between horses, took the rail into the second bend and was empty for the drive.
