Footnotes

PERSHING rated outside the early speed, was let out three wide on the second turn, took a narrow advantage upper stretch, was under a drive the last eighth and shook free in the waning yards. NEWTONS THEORY caught five wide into the first turn, soon circled foes to share the lead just outside LUMPY'S ACE, was put to a drive at the head of the lane, tried hard but did not have enough left inside the final sixteenth. LUMPY'S ACE soon had a narrow advantage, gained the inside entering the backstretch, shared the lead, was also put to a drive into the stretch, began to wear down inside the last eighth but was clearly best of the rest. OUR BIG SQUEEZE chased from just off the inside, angled out to follow PERSHING on the second bend, fanned out to path four entering the stretch, drifted out then back in nearing the furlong marker and leveled off late. POWERFUL PETE gradually backed up from inside, swung out to path three into the lane, angled out some for room upper stretch, was forced in with a furlong to go and also flattened the final sixteenth.
