BRAX was settled while racing three wide, rallied five wide on the turn, was in a long drive then dug in throughout the stretch and drew off in the end. ELUSIVE JAZZ TIME duelled for the lead while two wide, was in a long drive then gamely dug in but was second best. M H RANSOM was unhurried early then rallied and swung out to be six wide in upper stretch and closed willingly in late stretch. PACHE ECHO STAR was unhurried early then made a mild rally while two wide and was no threat. TRICK RYDER chased the early pace while racing three wide, made a three wide bid at the top of the stretch then faltered. KAREN'S MIRACLE was inside then saved ground on the turn but lacked a rally. BRITTANY BOY duelled for the lead from the inside, was in a long drive then weakened in the stretch. LIGHTNING CANYON trailed throughout.
