**Footnotes**

GOLD ASURE difficult to control leaving the chute, quickly vied for the lead once under control, edged ahead along the rail on the turn, opened up when asked upper stretch and held sway under steady urging. MOVE MOVES a bit awkward at the start, was settled at the back and outside, advanced three wide on the turn, lost ground fanning to path seven for room into the stretch, closed well, was too late but caught DOUBLE SMART for second. DOUBLE SMART vied for the early lead from outside, was just outside GOLD ASURE taking the turn and lacked the needed late kick. WAYMORE'S BLUES was hustled along to stay close, four wide through the bend then found best stride too late. DESERT GAMBLE prominent between horses, was just off the inside on the turn, had an easy striking position in the lane but could not close the gap appreciably. SPELLING BEE JONES void of speed from outside, advanced four wide on the bend, fanned out further entering the stretch and failed to have a significant response. ROMEOS WILSON was also without early foot, just off the inside on the turn, lost ground fanned six wide into the lane and was looking for a clear path most of the way. FLOMOT without speed from inside, saved ground on the turn, swung around the fading M H RANSOM upper stretch and failed to have a serious late bid. M H RANSOM was gradually angled in trying to gain a clear path just behind the pacesetters on the backstretch then gave way along the rail on the turn.
