Footnotes

PACHE ECHO STAR stalked the pacesetter from path four, went for the lead just outside ELEGANT MOVES on the second turn, was carried out to path five by the latter into the lane, battled with a narrow advantage through the stretch, lugged in a bit inside the final sixteenth, bumped ELEGANT MOVES and held on. ELEGANT MOVES bumped at the start, soon took the lead, set the pace just off the inside, drifted out to path four entering the stretch, fought in close quarters just inside PACHE ECHO STAR, was bumped nearing the wire, forced in some and had to settle for second. D E PARTYNEVERENDS bumped and squeezed at the break, was steadied, advanced three wide, swung out four wide on the second turn, lost further ground staying outside the top pair into the stretch, slowly closed the gap, was too late but easily best of the rest. RIVER JONES hesitated then lunged outward at the break, had no early speed from outside, angled in on the second turn and passed some tired ones in the stretch. SAN PEDROS LOBO broke outward, bumping solidly with D E PARTYNEVERENDS, was prominent from inside, failed to stay close on the second turn, came off the rail some entering the stretch, regained a striking position but leveled off in the late going. OTILIO was an early contender while in hand from outside, could not keep up while three wide on the second bend and had no significant stretch response. BIG BRYCE also broke outward, soon trailed from inside, floated out some for the stretch run and proved empty. There was a stewards' inquiry into the stretch run for the top two finishers but no action taken after their review.
