Footnotes

DESERT GAMBLE broke outward, bumping PECOS VALLEY WIND, was unhurried and kept outside, commenced his bid after a half mile, moved to the rail into the second bend, swung out to path three into the stretch, altered out to the middle of the track approaching the furlong marker, took the lead after entering the final sixteenth and drew off. LOTA TALENT stalked the early speed from three wide, floated out some as he went for the lead entering the lane, gained the advantage soon after, edged ahead inside the last eighth but was no match for DESERT GAMBLE through the waning yards. RUNNIN RED boxed in through the early going, was steadied lacking room nearing the second bend, split rivals three wide leaving that turn, dueled for the lead, could not stay with LOTA TALENT after entering the last eighth and could only stay clear for the show late. BROTHER LOUIE altered in early on, was rated off the inside, commenced his bid just off the rail on the second turn, was blocked at the head on the lane, altered out to gain a clear path five wide shortly after that, had a striking position with a furlong to go but hung through the waning yards. PECOS VALLEY WIND bumped at the start, was caught five wide through the first bend, helped prompt the pace from outside, went for the lead four wide on the second turn, fanned out further into the stretch and began to yield. LE GRANDE'S SPIRIT contested the pace inside from the beginning but did not have enough left for the drive. DUELING DOM vied for the lead just outside LE GRANDE'S SPIRIT for more than a six furlongs then tired. Due to a timer malfunction, the race was hand timed with no internal fractions available.
