**Footnotes**

FOREST MOUSE stalked from between horses, took over two wide into the second bend, was clear leaving that turn, floated out to path four entering the lane, was all out the last eighth and held on. RED LEAD forwardly placed just outside FOREST MOUSE, also made his bid on the second turn, lost some ground staying outside the latter into the stretch, moved clear for second and was getting to the leader through the waning yards. HURRICANE LAKE a step slow at the break, progressed while toward the outside to loom a threat four wide on the second turn, was forced to fan to path seven for the stretch run, could only make up minor ground in the late going but gained third. STACHYS bumped at the start, raced in contention between horses, was three wide into the second bend, swung out to path six into the lane, battled for third, lugged in some with a sixteenth left and was outfinished for the show. WATCH ME GO broke inward, bumping STACHYS, was wide through the first bend, progressed from outside on the backstretch to have an easy striking position five wide on the second turn, lost even more ground coming widest into the stretch, fought for third but leveled off inside the final furlong. WHERE'S THE REMOTE gradually backed up along the rail, saved ground through the second turn, as well, came off the rail midstretch and passed between tired rivals. FIRST STRIKE contested the pace just outside THIRTYFIRSTSTREET, moved ahead of that one on the backstretch and took the rail, lost the lead into the second turn and began to tire. THIRTYFIRSTSTREET displayed early speed from inside, could not keep up on the backstretch, came off the rail some, fanned out three wide for the drive and had little left. MCKENNA'S JUSTICE also a step slow at the start, chased from between horses and gave way from path four into the second turn.
