WILD N PRECOCIUS was soon hustled clear, lengthened his lead while just off the inside through the bend then maintained full control under steady urging in the lane. DODSON without early speed between rivals, progressed four wide on the turn, angled in some leaving the bend, was caught in tight quarters between rivals and steadied upper stretch, battled gamely to the wire and edged ahead for the place. RADCLIFFE MAN broke alertly, was soon chasing the early speed from between horses, angled in some through the bend to be just off the rail leaving the turn, was forced in some as he fought for second upper stretch, tried hard but did not have enough late. BOLIVAR SHAG racing closest to the pacesetter from just outside, floated out some entering the stretch, lugged in a bit, crowding those inside him approaching the furlong marker, fought to keep second but did not have enough left. BUCKSTER chased from outside, drifted out through the bend and could only make up minor ground deep stretch. NEW MEXICO KID made a small, awkward leap from the gap, showed no speed from outside, lost ground five to seven wide taking the turn then closed the gap some the last furlong. LILS KING stumbled at the break, was bumped solidly by HERBAL SLEW, chased, staying off the inside, came five wide into the stretch and lacked a significant response. GRANDAN in contention early, faded inside on the turn, angled out upper stretch and continued to fade. MR. SPEEDWHEEL MAN soon trailed, gradually angled in taking the bend, floated out some for the stretch run and had little to offer. HERBAL SLEW also stumbled at the start, bumped LILS KING and lost his rider. There was a stewards' inquiry into the start but no action taken after their review.
