MISS BULLETTE stalked from between horses, was carried out as she made her bid at the leader entering the stretch, soon took over then steadily drew off while ridden out. BELLE OF ABO broke in stride, was hustled along just of the inside, drifted out to path six into the lane, was no match for MISS BULLETTE but held second under a steady drive. STORMIN BOMB moved to the outside nearing the turn, gradually angled in leaving the bend, altered outside BELLE OF ABO midstretch and finished on even terms with that one. TOMMY JO without early speed from outside, angled in to be just off the rail entering the turn, moved out some when STORMIN BOMB took her path upper stretch and was closing the gap on the second flight through the waning yards. MOCHA BEAN pressed the early speed from outside, began to yield four wide leaving the turn, fanned out widest for the drive and lacked the extra needed. KATIE'S PROSPECT was soon well back, saved ground and failed to have a significant stretch response.
