GOLDEN YANK was unhurried early, rallied nearing the quarter pole, split foes into the stretch four wide, kicked clear and was full of run late. POR QUE was within striking distance early, placed a bid to gain a short lead at the quarter pole, finished willingly but was no match late for the winner. NUMISMATIST raced mid pack, vied four wide nearing the quarter pole, showed some effort late to gain the place. AWESOME LAUNCH was void of early speed, fanned six wide into the stretch and showed some interest late. RED SKY DUBAI set the early pace, drew quickly clear, opened up into the backstretch and was finished early. HE'S EZE was allowed to settle early, made a move mid way then faded. PERSHING showed little in a dull effort. CAPE TIME chased the early leader then retreated.
