Footnotes

LEFTY WHO chased the early leaders racing off the rail, rallied angling out at the top of the stretch, dug in to gain the advantage, inched away and held gamely. SPRING TO TERAS was unhurried early, vied into the stretch angling out three wide and found his best stride late. DOUBLE SMART set the early pace, edged clear briefly down the backstretch, fought hard into the stretch then gave way grudgingly. STARLIGHT MESA was void of early speed while saving some ground, and showed some interest in the stretch closing along the rail. DREAM KIN was allowed to settle early, lost ground nearing the quarter pole then placed a mild effort late. WAYMORE'S BLUES was off slow early and improved his position in the stretch. FLOMOT made a move mid way then faded. TEJANO CAT was outrun early, went wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. MISSION DELTA forced the early pace from the outside, gained a short lead at the quarter pole, was used up early, had nothing left for the stretch and stopped.
