GUIDING HAND set the early pace, drew clear, was challenged down the backstretch briefly, responded to the pressure, edged clear and just lasted in the final strides. DUNSCOMBE tracked the early leaders, vied three wide into the stretch, closed with urging and just missed. PERSHING prompted the early pace from the outside, sustained a brief bid down the backstretch then weakened. DOMENICK'S DUNE dropped back and was never a factor.
