MAXIMUS BEAUTY steadily progressed inside and gained a stalking spot near the five eighths, was patiently handled leaving the three eighths, angled out then edged up between foes into the lane, dropped to the rail soon after, closed inside the dueling rivals and poked a head in front in mid stretch, kept on under strong handling and edged clear late. RING ME UP stalked the pace three wide, was under pressure mid turn, moved four wide to challenge in upper stretch, dueled past the eighth pole and continued willingly while gaining the place. NO FAULT prompted the pace outside of SEVENTH TEE, moved to command after a half mile, shook clear near the five sixteenths, was taken on from both sides in upper stretch, dueled between foes past the furlong grounds and gave way grudgingly. SAVED BY THE SWELL settled towards the inside, moved up leaving the far turn, angled out and rallied five wide past the quarter pole, switched to her left lead, failed to kick on leaving the eighth pole and gave way. WHOLEHEARTED lacked speed, came four wide for the drive but lacked a bid. GULF VIEW, in tight soon after the break, lagged off the rail, saved ground into the lane and failed to menace. WALTZWITHECURLIN gave early chase and weakened. SEVENTH TEE cleared early, set the pace toward the rail, handled outside pressure from the five eighths to the half mile marker, failed to keep up with NO FAULT leaving the five sixteenths and retreated.
