Footnotes

HAVANA broke in at the start and was corrected, tracked the pace inside in hand, assumed command three furlongs from home under his own power, inched away to the top of the stretch, cornered just off the inside into the lane roused for the stretch drive, edged clear to the eighth pole, dug in under a drive under threat in the last seventy yards and just held game on the wire. HONOR CODE broke a bit awkward at the start, got lightly coaxed along three wide at the rear, commenced further encouragement midway on the turn, angled seven to eight wide circling RIDE ON CURLIN into upper stretch, unleashed a bold rally through the final furlong and just missed. RIDE ON CURLIN just off the inside towards the rear, shifted to the rail at the half mile pole, commenced encouragement three furlongs out, angled six to seven wide for home inside the aforementioned rival, offered up a good kick to close in late and garner the show well clear of the rest. CASIGUAPO just off the inside in mid pack, came under coaxing at the nine-sixteenths, got set down swinging three to four wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild kick through the drive for the last major share. INTENSE HOLIDAY forwardly placed three to four wide in pursuit from close range, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun three to four wide into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. LONG ON VALUE stumbled slightly at the start and came in on HONOR CODE a bit as he recovered his footing, settled three wide in mid pack, came under urging at the three-eighths pole then weakened in the drive. STRONG MANDATE three to four wide towards the rear, got spirited up three furlongs from home, spun five wide into upper stretch and was unable to make an impact. GRAND ARRIVAL broke out at the start, raced three wide in close aim of the front, angled to the rail placed to encouragement three furlongs out, cut the corner into the stretch in retreat and tired. DEBT CEILING coaxed on the pace just off the inside through solid fractions, capitulated the front midway on the turn, tried to get out through the latter portion while giving way and was not persevered with through the final furlong.
