FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. Northern Hemisphere Three-Year-Olds, 122 lbs.; Older, 126 lbs.; Southern Hemisphere Three-Year-Olds, 117 lbs.; Older, 126 lbs. All Fillies and Mares allowed 3 lbs. \$30,000 to pre-enter, \$60,000 to enter, with guaranteed \$3 million purse including nominator awards of which 54% to the owner of the winner, 18% to second, 9.9% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth; plus stallion nominator awards of 3% to the winner, 1% to second and 0.55% to third and foal nominator awards of 3% to the winner, 1% to second and 0.55% to third. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One and One Half mile.)

Footnotes

DANGEROUS MIDGE , fractious in the post parade, moved up four wide into the first turn and stalked CHAMP PEGASUS, made his initial move leaving the half mile marker, dropped back a bit off the leader while under strong urging leaving the three eighths pole, came back relentlessly under left handed pressure to draw even a sixteenth out then edged away late. CHAMP PEGASUS cleared early and set a moderate pace while kept in the three path, was joined by the winner around the far turn, moved back clear under little encouragement three furlongs out, responded when set down in upper stretch, was collared by the winner inside the furlong marker, dueled briefly then gave way grudgingly while clearly second best. BEHKABAD (FR) , taken to rate off the rail and inside rivals while within range, made steady progress leaving the eighth pole then went evenly through the final sixteenth. WINCHESTER , under rating while also off the rail, shifted out three to four wide in the drive but could only muster a mild late response. DEBUSSY (IRE) was steadied when rank entering the first turn, raced inside rivals while two to three wide early, dropped to the rail for the run around the final turn, gained some in mid stretch then faded in the final yards. TELLING stalked the pace three to four wide while under a hold, came five wide under a ride entering the lane and failed to respond. AL KHALI , under a snug hold while losing ground five wide, failed to respond when called upon leaving the three eighths pole and gave way.
