AEQUOR moved up to challenge for lead at the start, vied along inside of CHASE YOUR DREAM through backstretch and continued in far turn, edged away to clear lead still racing in hand at quarter pole, roused two wide into stretch, came under strong right handed drive, found another kick in reserve and pulled away. C K DEXTER HAVEN was rated off top trio in early stages, picked up the pace along inside in the turn then angled out turning for home, produced solid run for AEQUOR but could not reach rival, kept along for second best. TITOCCHIP broke near the back then hustled up closer along inside, steadied near three eighths pole then angled out and gained four to five wide in lane, finished well clear over rest. TOSS raced up close racing along outside just off top pair, could not maintain close advantage with eventual winner but remained in solid contention at quarter pole, came out five wide top stretch then began to fade. XIROMA raced off early speed then hustled up between rivals leaving the backstretch, saved ground along rail in turn, moved into contention then failed to sustain bid. NAVASODA trailed far back, raced very wide in stretch and passed couple tiring foes. CHASE YOUR DREAMS vied for lead racing along outside of eventual winner, could not match strides midway through turn but continued in pursuit then quickly retreated in upper stretch. CHARLIE'S COUSIN showed early response then dropped far back.
