SWEET SANDY , angled in early, saved ground around both turns, swung to the four path approaching the eighth pole, closed determinedly outside the winner and was up late. ARMOIRE , three wide the first turn, chased the pace, advanced along the inner rail to take the lead entering the stretch, opened up in mid stretch and tired late. QUEEN CAROLINE chased the pace outside GRACE IS READY down the backstretch and on the far turn, reached contention three deep turning for home then gave way. STREET MIZ , four deep entering the first turn, angled in on the backstretch, saved ground around the far turn and failed to rally. ANDRASTA was not a factor. COMPLETE ST. hesitated then hopped at the break, was outrun and circled the far turn four wide. GRACE IS READY sped to the early lead, set the pace near the rail, was in the two path leaving the far turn and faltered. SECRET OR NOT was outrun.
