POSEIDON'S WARRIOR raced close up outside, bid three wide on the turn, took charge with authority and kicked clear under urging. VALUE ADDED TAX was bumped at the start, chased inside, came out on the turn, rallied four wide past the quarter pole and finished well. PRINTING PRESS was bumped at the start, raced inside, angled out, came four wide into the lane and rallied mildly outside. GAITHER DRAW raced between foes, was steadied at the seven sixteenths marker, lugged out on the turn and raced greenly in the stretch. TELL TALE FRIEND dueled inside and tired. FEDERAL EXCHANGE dueled outside and tired. BAIL OUT THE CAT raced three wide off the pace, came five wide into the stretch and failed to rally. SOUPA MON was outrun.
