THREE YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$300 which shall accompany the nomination, original nominators paying \$3,000 to pass the entry box and \$3,000 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made by the closing time of entries at a fee of \$7,500 which qualifies to start with \$600,000 Guaranteed of which 60% to the Owner of the winner plus 50 Kentucky Derby points, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to be divided equally among all other starters. WEIGHTS: 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2013 allowed 3 lbs.; \$40,000 at a mile or over anytime 5 lbs.; \$25,000 at any distance 7 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered.) In Allowance Stakes starting preference will be given to horses that have accumulated the highest earnings. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. The Owner of the winner to receive a trophy. Early Bird closing Friday, February 8, 2013 at \$500 for The Southwest, The Rebel and The Arkansas Derby. Closed Friday, March 8, 2013 with 131 nominees.

WILL TAKE CHARGE broke in, straightened to settle off the pace and the inside, raced in traffic into the far turn, four wide through that bend when moving a bit closer, lost some ground into the lane, set down, late surge to be up at the wire. OXBOW within striking distance on the outside early, maintained contact with the leaders in the run up the backstretch, ranged up to challenge three wide late in the second turn, showed the way into the lane, came in a bit past the furlong marker, led late, could not contain the winner, clearly second best. DEN'S LEGACY broke in, lacked early foot inside, advanced along the rail into the far turn, challenged along the inside turning for home, bumped when vying upper stretch, could not match the top two late, saved the show. TEXAS BLING off the pace while racing toward the inside, advanced along the rail in the second turn, moved off the inside for the drive, flattened out a bit the final furlong. SUPER NINETY NINE forced the issue from the outside into the first turn, stalked the leader up the backstretch, went after that foe into the far turn, briefly gained the advantage, vied between foes into the lane, was beginning to tire when squeezed a furlong out, continued to back up. CARVE took far back, continued well back into the final turn, angled out through traffic into the lane, displayed a modest amount of late interest. TITLE CONTENDER away in good order, a bit rank when showing the way into the first turn, settled a bit in the run up the backstretch, weakened when headed in the final turn. TREASURY BILL squeezed back at the start, lacked speed, raced in some traffic turning for home, lacked a late punch when clear for the drive.

HARDROCK ELEVEN bothered at the start, raced back, four wide into the lane, also managed little in the way of a late rally. STORMY HOLIDAY was finished after a half. DELHOMME unruly saddling, raced forwardly early, also finished after four furlongs, fell quickly back, distanced.
