FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination, \$325 to pass the entry box. \$325 additional to start with \$75,000 Guaranteed, (plus \$25,000 for Registered Maryland Breds) of which 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 1% to sixth. Weights: Three-Year-Olds, 120 lbs.; Older, 124 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes in 2013 allowed, 2 lbs.; \$60,000 in 2013, 4 lbs.; \$50,000 in 2013 allowed, 6 lbs. (Maiden, Claiming and Starter races not considered in estimating allowances). Preference to starters with highest career earnings in 2012-13 on the Turf. Horses may be placed on the also-eligible list. Trophy to the owner of the winner. Nominations closed Friday April 12, 2013 with 30 nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race on the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth).

Footnotes

EIGHTTOFASTTOCATCH cleared early, set the pace under a light hold while towards the inside, responded when asked to pick up the pace leaving the five sixteenths marker, widened under left handed pressure in mid stretch, drifted out a bit, was corrected with the right stick a sixteenth out then held firm. LUBANGO , three wide early, raced in closest pursuit of the winner, was put to ride leaving the far turn, gave game chase and was clearly second best. CONCEALED IDENTITY saved ground while in range early, could not go on with the top pair mid way on the final turn, bumped soundly with DONE TALKING in mid stretch then edged that one in the battle for the show. DONE TALKING hopped at the break then was steadied back from between runners early, raced removed from the rail, came under a ride around the final turn, drifted in leaving the eighth pole bumping CONCEALED IDENTITY then was edged for the show. SEE TOBE , forward the opening quarter mile, saved ground and dropped back.
