Footnotes

FORTY TALES settled well back in the field while on the inside of DECLAN'S WARRIOR, raced inside early on the turn, angled three wide near the three-eighths pole, was put to a stronger ride, moved out under a left-handed whip in upper stretch, gained into the final furlong, switched to a right-handed whip outside the sixteenth-pole and closed strongly to get up in the shadow of the wire. MICO MARGARITA was brushed in the hindquarters at the start, tracked the pace on the outside, was fanned out by the pacesetter midway down the backstretch, dropped in near the half-mile pole, chased off the rail early on the turn then dropped to the inside, made a bid passing the five-sixteenths pole when MENTOR CRANE continued to get out, entered the stretch side by side with RAINBOW HEIR, drifted out under a left-handed whip near the three-sixteenths pole, was straightened by the rider and switched to a right-handed whip, shook clear into the final furlong, remained clear into the final sixteenth but was caught in a good effort. SALUTOS AMIGOS was well placed just off the pace, raced inside early on the turn, came off the rail while hard ridden at the five-sixteenths, dropped back to the inside while under the whip in upper stretch and finished with good courage to get the show. MENTOR CANE brushed the outside of the gate at the start, showed good speed, went to the front then began to drift well out in the track, was allowed to do so by the rider without much adjustment with the left-rein, entered the turn in the four path, lugged out to the six path by the three-eighths pole while being kept in by left-rein pressure, lost the lead near the five-sixteenths pole, continued six wide into the stretch, fought on into the final furlong and was outfinished. DECLAN'S WARRIOR lacked early speed while urged along, raced off the rail on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and gained ground belatedly but failed to threaten. RAINBOW HEIR bumped with CAT FIVE HURRICANE at the start, was forwardly placed on the outside while being fanned out by the leader, went five wide early on the turn despite room to the inside of the aforementioned rival, dropped to one off the rail near the three-eighths pole, made a bid alongside MICO MARGARITA at the five-sixteenths, was carried out by that rival near the three-sixteenths pole, dropped back coming to the furlong marker and tired. CAT FIVE HURRICANE bumped with RAINBOW HEIR at the start, was coaxed along while off the pace, dropped back leaving the backstretch, raced off the rail early on the turn, moved closer to the inside at the five-sixteenths pole and failed to respond.
