STAKES Toyota Saratoga Special S. Grade 2 - Thoroughbred

FOR TWO YEAR OLDS. By subscription of \$200 each which should accompany the nomination; \$1,000 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,000 to start. For horses not originally nominated, a supplemental payment of \$2,000 along with the entry and starting fees may be made at any time prior to the closing of entries. The purse to be divided 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% divided equally among the remaining finishers. The owner of any two year old who has broken its maiden in a race held at the Aqueduct Spring or Belmont Spring/Summer meetings is eligible to receive a one time \$100,000 bonus should that horse go on to win a graded sweepstake at any NYRA track in 2014. The bonus will be reflected in the horse's earnings. 122 lbs. Non-winners of \$40,000 allowed 2 lbs.; a race other than maiden or claiming, 4 lbs. A trophy will be presented to the winning owner. Closed Saturday, July 26, 2014 with 16 Nominations.

Footnotes

I SPENT IT lost his footing at the start, tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, remained on hold approaching the quarter pole, lacking usable options, slipped into the two path at the head of the stretch to no avail, altered course back to the rail near coming to the eighth pole, idled for a couple of jumps before having the former pacesetter drift out just enough to open up just enough room to slip by a tightly-bunched group, did so with a nice turn of acceleration, steadily extended the margin to remain comfortably in the clear. MR. Z was bumped from both sides at the start, was coaxed along giving chase from the two path on the turn, fanned outward travelling through the furlong grounds until five wide, arrived at the eighth pole poised to take over, got beaten to the lead by the winner, continued onward in a willing manner to secure the place. W V JETSETTER drifted outward after bobbling at the start, departed the backstretch from the four path, angled a couple of paths wider during initial portion of the stretch drive, rallied for the show award. CLEVELAND SOUND darted over into the two path midway down the backstretch, was asked to pick up the pace midway on the turn, entered the stretch and proceeded to wander over into the five path during the ensuing furlong, remained stuck behind a wall of rivals, espied a seam closer to the rail in the

vicinity of the sixteenth pole and eagerly altered course into the two path, dug in well to hold on to the final check. CINCO CHARLIE pressed the issue from the two path, doing so from between rivals during the latter stages of the run around the bend, remained a prominent factor to before giving way in the final furlong. STANFORD bobbed at the start, was hung out four wide for the majority of the way around the turn, commenced the stretch from the seven path, lacked the needed response. NONNA'S BOY established command, set a sharp pace from the inside, with CINCO CHARLIE applying pressure to the outside, had MAJESTIC AFFAIR increase it past the midway point on the turn, drifted into the two path coming to the eighth pole, relinquishing to severe pressure at this juncture, and gave way. MAJESTIC AFFAIR was taken hold after breaking slightly to the outside, raced three wide on the turn, ranged up enough to become a pace factor past the three-eighths pole, backed away steadily after turning for home. ROD MCLEOD came in and was bumped at the start, left the half mile pole between rivals, tired. LORD TYRION brushed at the start, saved ground, failed to pick up the pace when asked to midpoint on the turn. The purse reflects a \$100,000 NYRA 2-year-old graded stakes bonus paid out to the winner.
