Footnotes

PRINCESS OF SYLMAR was brushed and forced towards the rail a bit at the start, was put to a firm hold and proceeded to rate kindly at or near the two path, got maneuvered outward until in the four path coming to the midway point on the far turn, was placed under some mild hand urging and powered past the front runners to take command a sixteenth later, edged away comfortably and spun into the lane, drew out to her biggest advantage with an eighth to go, was given a sole shot from the stick, kept primarily to a brisk hand ride the final furlong, with the pilot intermittently flashing the whip from the right side. FIFTYSHADESOFHAY raced three wide around both turns, making her presence felt stalking the front runners, was still three wide but now between rivals leaving the three-eighths pole, got shaken off in short order by the top one, was set down for the stretch, finished willingly but had to settle for the place. CARNIVAL COURT broke slightly inward, initiating some light contact with the winner and carrying that opponent momentarily closer to the rail, went on to establish control and got positioned along the inside route, was well-rated, with another pair in close proximity parked out in paths two and three, continued along under the same conditions until halfway around the far turn, had the top one advance strongly into contention by this juncture, got displaced by the lightly-urged foe near the five-sixteenths marker and faltered. GALLOPING GIRAFFE rode the rail, one-paced, and isolated from the others, picked up the pace somewhat leaving the midway point on the second bend, was under urging fanning into the five path for the commencement of the stretch, drifted a bit wider shortly afterwards, made no impact. MONTANA NATIVE along the rail for most of the way down the homestretch, was guided into the two path nearing its end, prompted the leader from between rivals until the later stages of the run around the far turn then gave way.
