MISS B R H broke well, was immediately challenged by STORMING WHO, gave up the lead for a brief second, repulsed the bid and drew off late. DIABOLICAL DAME raced in the second flight, advanced seven wide into the second turn, was gaining late and was no match for the winner. STORMING WHO was fast early, vied at the quarter pole, challenged leader through the turn and steadily weakened in the drive. I AM DANDY mid pack early, advanced five wide into the stretch under steady urging and finished evenly. DESERT CAT unhurried early, angled out six wide into the turn and offered no bid in the drive. RUBY RED RYDER was allowed to settle early, moved three wide into the turn and finished evenly. VIA VIA mid pack early, saved ground throughout and offered no rally. WAR CHIC saved ground and was never a threat. HIGH ON FRESA saved ground and never was a factor. CLASSY ATTITUDE raced wide throughout and tired in the stretch.
