VERNISSAGE was forwardly placed early, rallied six wide and showed some interest late but didn't have enough to catch the winner. FONZERELLI forced the early pace, went six wide into the stretch, lacked a gain and went evenly. ROLL OUT THE BAND was off slow early and gained steadily four wide. WEEPING ALY set a pressured early pace from along the inside then weakened. DONTCHACALLNOMO was never far back early, placed a brief bid three wide then flattened. BEAUMONT TIME was unhurried early and lacked a late response. TORNILLO was outrun early, went six wide near the quarter pole and lacked a rally. BOBCAT RAY raced mid pack five wide then faded. CASINO JAX dropped back and trailed throughout.
