IRISH YOU WELL tracked early from just off the rail, moved to the front nearing the quarter pole and drew clear into midstretch then was under heavy handed pressure while holding off a rival through the late stages. JUST CALL KENNY brushed while in close at the start, raced well placed outside, moved up four wide entering the far turn, was three deep passing the quarter pole then in the four path again entering the stretch and finished gamely. ENCRYPTION set the pace inside, was just off the rail into the stretch then was not good enough while holding for a share. ALL TIED UP broke inward causing crowding, raced just off the inside turning for home and needed more. MISCONNECT was in tight and bumped between rivals at the start, saved ground and was asked on the second turn, moved just off the inside in upper stretch and lacked the needed response. WISE CHILD bumped in tight and squeezed back leaving the gate, had no rally. TIZ'NAZ raced up close three wide into the far turn and weakened. PASS THE COFFEE came out some and bumped leaving the gate, saved ground into the far turn and lacked a bid then was not urged late.
