Footnotes

GUN RUNNER broke sharp then steadily angled in to race two wide on first turn just off front runner, continued to rate nicely sitting just off COLLECTED in early backstretch before inching up to apply pressure, edge up on equal terms near half mile marker then edged by to take command three furlongs from home, presented with a challenge from WEST COAST midway through far turn, roused under strong hand ride entering lane, came under left handed encouragement at eighth pole, responded, turned back rival's bid and held firm. WEST COAST gained forward placing shortly after the start and firmly rated just off inside in the first turn, continued well spotted not far off early pace positioned three to four wide through the backstretch, commenced bid three path near five sixteenths pole, put to drive approaching quarter pole readily drawing into striking range, continued to loom serious threat to GUN RUNNER approaching eighth pole before rival found more in reserve and began to move away, remained solid to finish clearly second best. GUNNEVERA dropped to inside to save ground nearing first turn, remained unhurried saving ground positioned just off inside running through the backstretch, picked up pace two wide before dropping back to rail midway through far turn, roused up inside at head of the lane, was no match for pulling away top pair but dug in with good effort to capture share. FEAR THE COWBOY was slow away from the gate and three wide on the first turn, was roused sharply midway around the far turn, moved out to the five-path for the drive and kept on with good courage outside SEEKING THE SOUL to earn fourth money. SEEKING THE SOUL strung out four wide first turn, found best stride turning for home, kept on evenly and could not gain late. STELLAR WIND steadied into first turn as GUNNEVERA cut over, steadied inside TOAST OF NEW YORK on the far turn, then veered out under pressure in deep stretch. COLLECTED hustled up at the start to take over lead and angled in to secure rail position going into first turn, set solid pace on top with GUN RUNNER not far behind, came under pressure from rival then raced near equal terms half mile marker, lost lead to eventual winner three furlongs out, kept under drive two path at head of the lane before fading. SHARP AZTECA was outsprinted to the first turn by COLLECTED, steadied resisting restraint, stayed in range for six furlongs but had no response three wide on far turn. GIANT EXPECTATIONS was strung out wide early, raced forwardly to late far turn then tired. WAR STORY raced widest turning into the backstretch and was finished before going six furlongs. SINGING BULLET saved ground and was always outrun. TOAST OF NEW YORK hustled up in range to the backstretch, then tired after six furlongs.
